Parkville Netball offers competitions of varying standards which will suit all levels of players, regardless of experience or ability.

Competitions are played at the State Netball Centre (SNC).

Divisions: 14&U Male, 17&Under Male, and Open Mixed

Umpires: Supplied by the competition

Entry Fee: \$96.00 per team in all competitions

Non-refundable if team withdraws

Credited towards match payments

Weekly Court Fees: \$96/game

All Entries Close: 11pm, Friday 28th February 2025

Note: All match times are indicative and subject to change pending team entries.

TEAM ENTRY PROCESS

All teams must enter via Netball Connect.

Players can only be added to teams once they have registered to the competition. Please ensure all players have registered to team prior to the closing date.

IMPORTANT COMPETITION INFORMATION

In entering a Team in the 2025 Autumn Season at Parkville Netball, you are agreeing to abide by the Rules and Regulations of the Competition, and that your team members acknowledge the dates and duration of the season.

Following are some important details that your Club/Team should be aware of relating to Parkville Netball's Male & Mixed Competition in 2025 in addition to the Bylaws.

1. Competition Correspondence and Enquiries

2. Netball Victoria Membership

All players, coaches and umpires must have a current Netball Victoria membership prior to taking to the court. Failure to have current membership will result a penalty of loss of 4 premiership points for the team.

Players must self-register online through Netball Connect using their club link or via the Netball Connect app. No registrations will be processed through the Competition Office.

Fill-in players who don't have a registration for 2025, can purchase a Single Game Voucher (SGV) on the Netball Connect app (\$5 seniors, \$3 for juniors). This will provide the player a temporary registration for that match only (cannot be transferred to another match or day).

3. Club Contact Details

Parkville Netball should be advised in writing of any changes to Club/Team Contacts during or between seasons. It is essential that contact details are accurate and current, otherwise important information may not be passed on to the Club/Team or its members.

All correspondence with Parkville Netball shall be made through the nominated Club/Team Contact only.

4. Bylaws / Codes of Conduct

All Clubs/Teams must adhere to Parkville Netball Bylaws and Codes of Conduct as a condition of their acceptance into the Competition.

5. Working with Children Checks (WWCC)

Under Victorian State Government regulations which came into effect on the 1st August 2017, all Clubs and Teams which have junior players under the age of 18, must ensure all of their staff and volunteers who hold positions of authority pass a Working with Children Check. It is the responsibility of all Clubs and Teams to provide the Competition with details of all current WWCC or submissions for an application for a check. Clubs must also view Team Umpires in the same way as Coaches and Team Managers and therefore are subject to the same prerequisites as them.

For Tuesday 17&Under, Thursday 15&Under and Saturday Junior competitions, where Clubs are to provide Team Umpires for all fixtured matches, WWCC information must be provided for each of these individual umpires (if 18 years or older) as well. If umpires are sourced through a third-party agency or representative, it is still the Club's responsibility to obtain WWCC details for these umpires and provide them to the Competition Office. *(Refer to page 6, dot point 10)*

If WWCC details are not provided, penalties will apply.

6. Fixtures

Fixtures for all competitions will be available on the website no earlier than 10 days prior to the commencement of the season. All competition fixtures, results, and ladders can be found on the Parkville Netball website or on the Netball Connect App.

7. Team Lists

Clubs are to submit their Team Lists through Netball Connect upon entering the Competition. Clubs can make changes to individual teams each week, and if they need a fill-in, this is also done through Netball Connect.

It is the responsibility of the club to ensure that all regular players in a team have been included in on the Team List in Netball Connect. Any borrowed players must be added to the app when selecting team attendance.

8. Forfeits

Should a team be in a position where it needs to forfeit their scheduled match, the Team/Club Contact must notify Parkville Netball in writing prior to 12:00am the day of the match (4:00pm Friday for Saturday matches). If a Team within a Club needs to give a forfeit, then only the nominated Club Contact must inform the Parkville Netball via email (info@parkville.netballvic.com.au). Failure to do so before this deadline will result in a forfeit fine being incurred.

All forfeits will still incur the full weekly fees invoiced at the start of the season. The team receiving the forfeit will not incur the weekly fees.

Where possible, a notification will also be sent out to affected team/s via the Netball Connect app. The Club/Team contact will also receive an email/phone call.

9. Team Umpires (in competitions indicated on page 1)

All Clubs/Teams must appoint an umpire that is the standard of the grade that they are officiating in. Clubs are **required** to supply the **Name, Badge and WWCC** of their team umpire to the **Competition Office** prior to the season.

Team Umpires are not permitted to umpire more than 3 matches in total for any Club/Team on any competition night/day.

Please refer to the bylaws for minimum badge requirements (if any) of team umpires. The Competition reserves the right to request the club to replace an umpire if that said umpire is not to the standard of the grade in which they are officiating. In the event of a forfeit or cancellation, it is the Club's responsibility to notify their umpire.

10. Team Duties

All Clubs/Teams playing at Riverside are required to assist with sweeping any water and puddles from the courts prior to the start of play at each round, to ensure that scheduled matches will commence on time.

Clubs/Teams playing in Saturday Juniors are required to assist with adjusting goal post and padding heights if they are scheduled to be on the courts at that time.

11. First Aid

The Competition offers basic first aid. We offer the services of a trained First Aid Attendant for all scheduled matches. First Aid Attendants will not do any preventative strapping of players pre-game.

12. Promotional Photos

All teams playing at Parkville Netball may be photographed for promotional use by the Competition on our social media channels.

When a player registers in Netball Connect, they are asked if they give consent for their photo to be taken and potentially used by Netball Victoria and/or Parkville Netball. Players can opt out of the consent.

13. Photos & Videos

If anyone wishes to take photos or videos during any scheduled match, whether it is on behalf of the Club/Team or for personal use, the photographer or video operator must complete a Photo & Video Consent Form. These are available to be downloaded from the Parkville Netball website or they are available from the Competition Supervisors on each day of competition.

Once submitted, the person MUST approach the other team, as a courtesy, to inform them that they intend to take photos and videos. The other team has the right to not allow photos to be taken during the match if there is a valid reason. If this is the case, the photographer or video operator is to refrain from taking any footage at all from the match.
